Number/Type of Members	11 members, 5 appointed from Waterville, 2 appointed from Winslow, 2 appointed from Fairfield, 1 appointed from Benton & 1 appointed from Vassalboro
Compensation	Chair, Vice-chair, treasurer and clerk may receive compensation as determined by the trustees, in addition to compensation received for being a Trustee. Trustees may receive up to \$10 per meeting as determined by the trustees.
Member Requirements	Must be residents of the respective community.
Member Restrictions	Municipal officers are not eligible to serve. Trustees may not be paid employees of the sanitary treatment district.

Nature of Work:

Trustees may adopt reasonable rules and regulations relative to its sewer treatment practices. Trustees plan for infrastructure improvements to include acquiring properties, authorizing contracts and agreements with corporations, districts or other government entities, vote to acquire bonds or notes to fund capital projects, review and adopt a budget for the district.

Duties and Responsibilities:

Attend scheduled meetings. Trustees may adopt, establish and amend policies and regulations to assist with the proper management of the district.

Specific Abilities and Requirements:

- Ability to work collaboratively in a group setting.
- Must adhere to the City of Waterville Code of Ethics.
- Knowledge of sewage treatment, storm water issues and underground utilities helpful.
