So you think you're a good shooter and you're ready to test yourself against players your own age. Then this event is for you!

The Maine Recreation and Parks Association (M.R.P.A.)/Red Claws Hot Shot competition is a basketball skills competition for youth **9-15 years of age**. It involves shooting from 5 "hot spots" marked on one end of the basketball court. This competition will test each contestant's speed, shooting, dribbling, and rebounding ability.



Each participant must first compete in a local Hot Shot event sponsored by your community recreation department (Waterville Parks & Recreation). Division winners will advance to the Regional Competition. After the completion of all regional events, the winners and runner-ups of each age division then advance to the M.R.P.A. Red Claws State Hot Shot Competition. Participants at the State Competition compete for first place and runner-up awards.
