Three written questions were received by the City requesting clarification to the Request for Qualifications.

QUESTIONS

- 1) Does the City intend to increase the maximum number of pages submitted from 20 to 30?
- 2) Does the 20 page limit originally defined include an allowance for resumes?
- 3) What is the scope of work that the Airport intends to pursue within the next year?

ANSWERS

The City understands that the MDOT usually limits the maximum pages to 30. In order to maintain our maximum limit of pages submitted to 20, the City will allow up to 10 pages of resumes to be posted online with links provided in RFQ.

The City will maintain the 20 page limit.

The City intends to secure a grant for all design services related to the reconstruction of our main runway, RW 5-23. The City understands that FAA funding may not be available to allow complete design in one funding cycle. The City desires to define the scope of work related to a complete design, and the City desires to have the entire scope and price reviewed and verified as eligible for reimbursement, prior to beginning any design work. The City desires the option to award the work in phases as grant funds become available.
