


Examples of Bike Lanes.

Bike Lanes come in a wide variety of styles. Some are located between an on-street parking zone and the automobile travel lane. Some are colored distinctly (usually green). Some are separated by additional painted lines or more substantial barriers from either parked cars or auto traffic. Almost all are marked with distinctive stencils, some with a rider, some with just a bicycle.



Sharrows

Sharrows are used where bike lanes are not feasible, usually due to the width of the street. The shared use stencil is distinctive. The photo to top left illustrates the safety issue posed by opening of car doors into the zone or lane used by cyclists.
