Garbage collection is a service just like electricity, gas and water. You pay for only what you use of these utilities. Why should garbage be any different?

It's not.

Thousands of communities across the United States have implemented a new system for paying for trash pick-up and disposal. It's called "PAY AS YOU THROW."

PAY AS YOU THROW is a system that charges residents for trash services based on the amount of waste they throw away. This system is fair to everyone and it puts you in control of how much you spend on trash.

*We encourage residents to take full advantage of the FREE zero sort, curbside recycling program to save the most money on trash collection.*

# Attention Waterville Residents: **PAY AS YOU THROW (PAYT)**

## Waste Reduction Program

**PAYT will begin the week of September 8,  
on your regular trash collection day.**

- ◆ Trash will only be picked up if it is in the City's **purple** bags.
- ◆ Bags can be purchased at most grocery stores (see *list below*)
- ◆ There are two (2) bag sizes: Large (30 gallon) and Small (15 gallon)
- ◆ Large bags include 5 bags per roll for \$10
- ◆ Small bags include 8 bags per roll for \$10
- ◆ There is no charge or change for those who do NOT currently have their trash collected by the City.

## Recycling

- ◆ Recyclables are collected curbside during the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> full weeks of each month, on your regular trash collection day.
- ◆ No sorting required.
- ◆ No special bins required. Containers must be clearly marked "Recycle" or "Recycling"
