Dear Coaches,

The Westbrook Paper City Classic Tournament Committee would like to invite your team to our annual tournament.

The dates for our tournament are:

March 18th through March 22nd 2015

We will have a pool play format. In order to guarantee every team, a minimum of three games.

Blue Division White Division

The two best records from each division in pool play will be in the Semi-Finals and Championship Game. In case of identical records, the tie breaker will be (1) the winner of head-to-head and (2) the team with the least amount of cumulative points allowed in Pool Play and (3) The least amount of cumulative points allowed in third game of Pool Play.

Entry fee will be \$165.00 per team

#### **A Foul Shooting Competition**

The coach from each team needs to select a player. That player will shoot 20 foul Shots. In the case of a tie, those players will shoot another 20 foul shots, until we determine a winner. All players must begin their free throw from behind the 15 foot free throw line, but may go over the line on their attempt. The winner will receive an indoor/outdoor basketball and a Foul Shooting Trophy.

If you would like to Register your team, please complete the enclosed roster form and return it with payment as soon as possible, as programs need to be printed. Please print roster legibly when completing the form. Incomplete roster forms will not be accepted.

**If you are not coaching the team this year, please forward the information to the present coach.**

# Westbrook's Annual Paper City Classic 5th Grade Girls' Basketball Tournament

1. The tournament is a Pool Play Format.
2. Entry fee is \$165.00 per team. Make checks payable to: Westbrook Paper City Classic.
3. All officials will be provided by the Paper City Classic Tournament Committee. Board officials will be used for all games.
4. All teams are required to have two sets of uniform shirts, each a different color and numbered on the back. Shirts may be T-shirts.
5. Team roster will be limited to a maximum of 16 players. No names may be added or changed once they have been turned in. If, for any reason, there is a question in the eligibility of any ball player, they will not be allowed to dress or play in any game until proven eligible to play. Games will not be delayed to prove eligibility and will continue as scheduled, any player found to be ineligible and playing in any game will cause team forfeiture of all games played. **Only 5th and 6th grade girls are allowed to play.**
6. Each team will be responsible for their own valuables. A team representative may collect all valuables upon arriving at the gymnasium. He (she) may then present all valuables to one of our tournament personnel, who will lock up the items for safe keeping until the team is ready to depart for home.
7. Teams must arrive at least one-half (1/2) hour before the start of their game. Report directly, **as a team**, to admission table for locker room assignment. Only **team coaches, players and managers** will be allowed into the games without paying admission fees.
8. Teams must be on the court, ready to play at game time or suffer forfeiture. In the event the previous game runs over the specified time limit, teams participating in the next game must be ready to play ten (10) minutes after the preceding game ends.
9. Each team coach will be responsible for presenting the Scorer's Table with the names of the starting line-up with uniform numbers and positions, plus the remaining names and members of team members within ten (10) minutes of game time. All players and coaches will be introduced over the P.A. system prior to their game, if time allows.
10. **No A.A.U. or All-Star teams are allowed In the Tournament.**

11. The coach of each team is responsible for the proper conduct of his/her players, other coaches, team members and fans associated with the team, as well as his/her own behavior while participating in the Tournament. If proper behavior is not exhibited by those people associated with said team, it could result in forfeiture of all games and expulsion from the tournament at that time and for future years.

12. Admission **fee per day** will be:

\$2.00 Youth (High School age & younger)

\$4.00 Adults

Admissions are for all games on that day.

13. Games will be 2 (15 minute) halves with the clock stopping for all dead balls. Half time will be 10 minutes, which at this time our Knock-Out competition will be held.

**(All proceeds will go to Special Olympics)**

**Any Remaining time can be used for warm-ups**

...Any protests will be handled by the Tournament Committee (consisting of the Tournament Directors and Referee-in-Chief of the Tournament.)

14. Each team is allowed 4 time-outs per game.

There will be no additional time-outs added for an overtime period.

15. In case of a tie, there will be a two minute overtime period.

16. The three point shot will be utilized in all games.

17. Foul Shots

All players must begin their free throw from behind the 15 foot free throw line, but may go over the line on their attempt, providing they are not trying to gain an advantage on the potential rebound.

18. Full Court Press - Any time (up to 10 points)

19. Only Person to Person Defense is allowed, an obvious zone defense would result with a warning. Continued abuse would result with a Technical Foul. An illegal defense is based on the Official's judgement. However you can double team the ball inside the three point arc.

20. Mercy Rule - Five minutes left in the game with a team leading by 20 points, clock will be running time for the remainder of the game.

21. Refreshments (hot dogs, soft drinks, and snacks) will be available for purchase at the concession stand located within the Middle School and High School.

22. Awards:

- A. First place will receive individual player championship trophy's, along with Championship T-Shirts.
- B. Second place will receive individual player trophy's.
- C. All others receive participation ribbons.
- D. M.V.P. trophy at the end of each game.

23. Weekday Games:

- 1st Game 5:45 PM
- 2nd Game 7:00 PM

24. All 5th grade teams must be comprised of a minimum of 70% 5th graders. Any 6th graders who have not been on your roster during your season, **are not eligible for the tournament.**

**Only one game will decide the Championship.**
