

# 2017 Recycling Calendar



**Recycling weeks are the first (1<sup>st</sup>) and third (3<sup>rd</sup>) FULL weeks of the month.**

 The **blue** recycling symbol indicates a **standard recycling week**. Pick-up is on your regular trash day unless it falls on a date a holiday is observed. When this occurs, pick-up is rescheduled for the next regular business day, with the exception of Thanksgiving Day, when it is collected the day before.

 The **red** recycling symbol indicates a **Courtesy Pick-Up recycling week**. (These are the weeks of: January 30<sup>th</sup> —February 3<sup>rd</sup> and May 29<sup>th</sup> —June 2<sup>nd</sup>)

# Recycling Information



## Recycling

- ◆ Curbside recycling is collected during the 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> **FULL** weeks of each month, on your regular trash collection day.
- ◆ No sorting or special bins are required. Containers must be clearly marked "Recycle" or "Recycling."
- ◆ **Do not use plastic bags except for shredded paper.**

- ◆ **Shredding on Site**, on Armory Road, also offers drop-off recycling for residents & businesses. **Hours:** Tues.-Sat. 8am-3pm; **FMI:** Call 872-2029



## Bulky Waste

Household items such as tires, TVs, mattresses, furniture, appliances, etc., can be disposed of at **Pine Tree Waste**, Airport Road, Waterville. Disposal fees may apply. **Hours:** Mon.-Fri. 7am-4:30pm; Saturdays 8am-12pm (**Dec. 1<sup>st</sup>-Apr. 1<sup>st</sup>:** Closed Saturdays & open Thursdays until 6pm) **FMI:** Call 873-1219, ext. #3

## Household Hazardous Waste

## Christmas Tree Recycling

Each year approx. 500-600 Christmas trees are picked up during the City's curbside collection in January. They are then used for a tree maze at the Quarry Road Recreation Area Winter Carnival and later chipped into mulch for erosion control on the Quarry Road trails. Collection dates are posted on our web site and City Facebook page in **January** of each year.
