## WELCOME to COUNTRY

*We belong to this country - Ngalingah gala djagun*

*We look after this country - Ngalingah gala mala djagun*

*We don't do any wrong around this country - Wana djangma mala gunah gala djagun*

*We don't harm this country - Ngalingah wana galaga mala djagun*

*We don't harm (it) - Ngalingah yagambeh djangma*






**BIODIVERSITY of Nimbin Rocks**

The properties biodiversity is significant as it supports a diversity of flora and fauna, five threatened and vulnerable flora species, four threatened fauna species and three vegetation communities listed as Endangered Ecological Communities under the NSW Threatened Species Conservation Act 1995.

Six Key Threatening Processes as listed on Schedule 3 Threatened Species Conservation Act 1995 have been identified to be operating on the property.





### VISION for the Nimbin Rocks Community

The Rangers are collecting, propagating and regenerating native plants that are suitable for bush food or other traditional uses. These plant species are part of a demonstration site and a Connection Walk to help restore and share Cultural knowledge amongst the local Indigenous Community and visitors.



### THE PEOPLE connected to Nimbin Rocks

Nimbin Rocks is an Aboriginal sacred site for all the people of Bundjalung. Ngumbijn or Nimbin Rocks was a shared ceremonial place for all of the Bundjalung Nation. People came from near and far to spiritually cleanse before taking part in initiation ceremonies for higher learning at the rocks and elsewhere.

Elders and community members desire to restore this area for cultural learning purposes to revive traditional culture. By caring for country, biodiversity and making connections between natural places, we create a strong and healthy environment.

Rangers are working to protect and restore the health of the Natural Values on two properties that surround this important sacred site and therefore restoring and protecting the Dreaming and Cultural Values of Nimbin Rocks.
