RESOLUTION 131-2017

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR:

SUPPORT FOR CHANGES IN DOWNTOWN TRAFFIC PATTERNS TO MAKE MAIN STREET AND FRONT STREET TWO-WAY STREETS

BE IT RESOLVED by the Waterville City Council, acting as the Municipal Officers,

THAT the City Council is in support of changes to downtown traffic patterns that would result in Main Street and Front Street becoming two-way streets. Major improvements could also be made at a number of intersections in the downtown area to improve pedestrian safety.

These changes and improvements would be in keeping with the recommendations of the **Downtown Feasibility Study** completed in December, 2016.

SUMMARY:

In order to seriously pursue outside funding sources, there has to be an expression of support by the City. Approval of this resolution will provide for that.

At this time, the City is not making any financial commitments. We are researching any and all options for funding.
