Dear Mr. McPherson:

The Maine Department of Transportation is currently working on developing bid documents for a pavement preservation project (1½ Inch Mill and Fill) along Route 11 (Kennedy Memorial Drive) in the City of Waterville. Construction is planned for the summer of 2021. The overall paving project begins 0.04 of a mile east of First Park Road (west of I-95) and extends east 1.69 miles (to Route 104, West River Road).

The City of Waterville has requested the sidewalk be rehabilitated as part of this project on the north side of Kennedy Memorial Drive beginning at 1st Rangeway and extending to Cool Street. The width of the existing sidewalk will remain the same (approximately six feet including granite curb). The existing sidewalk rehabilitation will include the following: removal of the existing pavement, resetting of granite curb as needed, new curb ramps at side streets and driveways, shim of gravel base, paving of sidewalk with hot mix asphalt and matching the back edge of sidewalk with the existing surface (pavement or grass). Some driveway entrances will also be rehabilitated to better match the sidewalk ramps. Only temporary construction property rights will be required for the sidewalk rehabilitation. The MaineDOT property office will be contacting all impacted property owners in the next few months. Temporary detours of pedestrian traffic will be used during the sidewalk rehabilitation. Additional sidewalk ramp work will be completed in 2022 as part of WIN 24301.00 (Build Grant Project) at the following signaled intersections: 1st Rangeway, JFK Plaza, Cool Street and Route 104 (West River Road).

We hereby request that you post this letter on any municipal public bulletin boards, media outlets and/or municipal websites as a public meeting will not be held regarding this project.

The total project cost is estimated at \$2,683,000. This project will be funded with Local, State and Federal funds.

The anticipated project schedule is as follows:

- Advertise Project for Bid – March 2021
- Construction Begin – May 2021
- Construction Complete – October 2021
