

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Games will comply with National Federation rules with the following exceptions:
 - A. Teams must play half-court man-to-man defense in the first half. Help and recover is allowed. Trapping is prohibited in the first half. Teams may apply any type of defense in the second half. Coaches are encouraged to discuss the interpretation of man-to-man defense with the official(s) prior to the start of the game.
 - B. Full court pressure is permitted when a team's lead is less than 10 points.
 - C. Any player will be allowed to jump over the foul line during a foul shot; however, if they do go over the line, they cannot be the first player to touch the basketball on a rebound. This will be a violation and the ball will be turned over to the other team. If the ball comes back to the shooter with no effort to retrieve the ball, this will not be a violation.
 - D. Violations of rule(s) A and/or B will result in a team warning for the first infraction and a technical foul for each subsequent violation. The technical foul will not count as a team or personal foul.
2. Games will be officiated by IAABO officials as often as possible. Use of Jr. IAABO officials is allowed as long as they are accompanied by a certified IAABO official.
3. A regulation game will consist of 2 twenty (20) minute half's with 3 minute overtime periods if necessary. Run time will be used; however, the clock will be stopped during the last two (2) minutes of each half and during any whistles or stoppage of play during any overtime period.
4. Half time will be 5 minutes unless otherwise agreed upon by both coaches.
5. Girls: Only players in the 5th or 6th grade will be allowed to play for the 5/6 level and only players in the 3rd and 4th grade will be allowed to play for the 3/4 level. No AAU teams or otherwise multi-community conglomerate teams; only localized recreation type teams are allowed to play.
6. Each team is allotted three 60-second time-outs and two 30-second time-outs during a regulation game. One additional 60-second time-out is allowed per overtime.
