PLEASE HELP SUPPORT QUARRY ROAD

Quarry Road Recreation Area Support Stickers are similar to seasonal ski trail passes, but are based on a donation system rather than a mandatory trail pass. Income generated from this system will go toward snow-making, grooming and trail maintenance. There are four suggested levels of support for winter use of ski trails. You choose the level that fits your budget and usage:

-  **Gold Level: \$100** (suggested for frequent use of ski trails)
-  **Silver Level: \$50** (suggested for regular use of ski trails)
-  **Bronze Level: \$20** (suggested for occasional use of ski trails)
-  **Day Pass: \$5** (suggested for infrequent use of ski trails)

PLEASE NOTE: A Support Sticker is not required to use the trails but to sustain the area it is hoped that all users consider an annual donation. Also note, the system as described above, is a trial - other facilities like Quarry Road charge a mandatory fee for groomed cross-country ski trails.


3. Deposit cash or check and pledge card in metal container to left of kiosk. (Contents checked daily)

Ski Only in Winter
-  5K Koons Competition (North and South Trails) Walk/Bike/Jog - 3 Seasons
Ski Only in Winter
-  1.4K Colby Sprint Loop
Ski Only in Winter
-  Inner Meadow Loop
Winter Walk/Jog/Bike
-  Riverview Path
Winter: Snow shoe/Walk
Year Long: Walk/Jog



Bikers: Avoid trail use if muddy or soft snow to prevent erosion and unsafe conditions for others.



Competition Trail to be skied in clockwise direction
Absolutely no dogs on ski trails during winter months
Please stay on marked trails
